



PATIO MISTER KIT SET UP/ TAKE DOWN PROCEEDURES

The following instructions are designed to help you easily set up and take down the Patio Mister System.

Set Up Guide

STEP 1: Locate closest house water spigot (connect garden hose if necessary).

STEP 2: Carefully unwind misting line.

STEP 3: Find best location for the On/Off valve (it hangs down 10' from first misting head).

STEP 4: The mister head at the end of the misting line should be installed with supplied plastic staples.

Note: If the installation is for a patio roof-line...it is suggested to install misting heads on the bottom edge of the fascia board.

STEP 5: Working from the farthest misting head backwards; install a staple between each misting head AND one at each misting head.

STEP 6: Make sure the line is pulled tight to prevent sagging.

STEP 7: Adjust mister heads to spray downward or at a 45 degree angle away from guest sitting area.

STEP 8: Connect Garden Hose Adapter to the house spigot (or the end of garden hose).

STEP 9: Turn on water source.

WHEN YOU WANT THE MISTER TO PROVIDE REFRESHING COOLING MIST, TURN THE "ON/OFF VALVE" IN THE ON POSITION (PARALLEL TO THE LINE).

Note: MISTER LINE SHOULD BE DRAINED AFTER EACH USE.

STEP 1: Turn OFF the water source (Garden Hose)

STEP 2: Turn On the On/Off Valve.

STEP 3: Disconnect Garden Hose Adapter from hose or spigot.

STEP 4: Let water drain from the tubing.

STEP 5: Reconnect Garden hose Adapter.

Maintenance

Included in your mister kit is an extra mister head. If you notice a head not providing a fine mist, turn off mister and replace head with spare mister head. To disconnect, push the ring at mouth of the fitting toward the fitting and simultaneously push/pull the tube out of it. You may need pliers; be careful not to pinch head or tubing.

To clean the head use CLR or Lime Away. Pour a small amount of CLR or Lime Away into a small container enough to cover mister head and follow instructions on bottle for how long to soak. Once head is clean it can be reinserted in the system.

Routine Maintenance

Heads should be routinely cleaned every 3 months or before a long storage using the instructions above, this will prevent the build up of calcium and lime in mister heads.
